

Shaping the future

Overview

The Geraldton Residential College (GRC) provides a supervised, quiet, and non-disruptive space for students to reflect and review the work they have done at school each day, and complete set homework.

GRC employs tutors on Monday through to Thursday evenings who supports **all students** from **all our partner schools**. Students in Year 7 to Year 9 are encouraged to make use of the supervised study time at GRC in line with our partner schools homework expectations.

Any student attending study time must always conduct themselves Respectfully and Responsibly or they will be asked to leave. The college collates a weekly report on student attendance.

Our Schools

Champion Bay Senior High School (CBSHS) holds a Homework club in their library on Wednesday afternoons from 3:15pm-4:30pm. CBSHS has no expectations for their students to attend extra study commitments on this day. School Homework policy suggests one hour per evening from Years 7-10 to undertake any set homework, revise learning from day or to read. Students in Years 11-12 can expect to complete at least one hour per evening, according to the needs of their courses. These students may have study blocks in their weekly timetable.

Geraldton Senior High School (GSHS) has no expectations that their students attend study time at the college.

Geraldton Grammar School (GGS) encourages their students to complete from 1 hour per night of set homework, revision or reading. GGS expect their boarding students to attend after school tutorials each Wednesday afternoon from 3:15pm - 4:00pm, as such, GGS are not expected to attend study time at the college on Wednesdays. GGS also has a DALTON period on a Tuesday and Thursday. This is a designated period where students in Year 7 to 10 can catch up on assessments or attend tutorials in hubs. Years 11 & 12 have designated student study periods in their timetable.

Nagle Catholic College (NCC) encourage their students to complete from 1 hour per night of set homework, revision or reading.. In addition, Year 11 & 12students may have designated study periods in their daily school timetable.

Geraldton Christian College (GCC) Geraldton Christian College has two homework Club sessions a week from 3:30 - 5:00 on Tuesdays and Thursdays in the Library. Students can choose to attend.
