Things to Note

College Bus Runs: Our courtesy bus service operates from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, unless prior arrangements have been approved by the College Manager.

Hair Cuts: We have experienced a common theme of students giving other students hair cuts within the college which have not met their respective school requirements. Moving forward, students are not to engage in this activity.

Dining Room: In accordance with the new Department of Education policy, enclosed footwear must be worn by all students and staff when in the dining room and kitchen areas.

Casual Employment: After consultation between parents, the student and the college manager, your child may be given leave to undertake casual employment. They are allowed to work a maximum of two nights per week from Sunday Night to Thursday and must finish no later then 9:00pm.

Students are free to work as many times as they wish Friday afternoon to Sunday afternoon, but must finish no later then 9:30 pm. Both parents and students must complete an agreement form at the start of any new employment.

Parent Consent Form: Please note that all parents/carers have been emailed the 2025 Annual Parent Consent Form, this must be returned to the College signed by both the parent/guardian and the student by the start of Term 1 2025. Until this form has been completed and signed, your child will not be able to participate in any college excursion or allowed on any college bus.
