## Workshop information sheet –2025 entry

**Please read the information below to help your child prepare for their Drama audition.**

Your child will take part in a range of activities to assist in the selection process. These may include:

- Group work and problem solving;
- Small group improvisation;
- Monologue presentation\* and
- Individual directions.

\*No preparation is required for the monologue presentation. Materials will be supplied at the workshop.

We aim to make the workshop environment encouraging and enjoyable for your child.

### What to wear

Please wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for free movement. Clothing such as tracksuit pants or shorts and a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. Applicants take part in the workshop in bare feet.

### Essential items to bring to the workshop

- The completed [Student Details Sheet](#) with a passport-sized photo attached
- The completed [Student Identification and Health Form for Arts Applicants](#)
- A photocopy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2023)
- A bottle of water

On arrival at the venue, hand your forms to the sign-in staff at the registration table. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of staff at this time. Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

**To allow us to effectively plan groups, please provide at least three days' notice if you wish to withdraw your child from their session.**

The workshop will take approximately two hours. We will confirm the finishing time when you arrive at the venue. Students must be collected promptly and signed out at the registration desk. If you or another parent/carer cannot collect your child from their workshop, you must make prior arrangement with us. Please contact the Gifted and Talented Unit before their session to arrange this.

## Adjusted Conditions

If your child has a disability, chronic illness or condition for which you believe they need Adjusted Testing Conditions you must apply before the deadline of Monday 19 February by submitting the [Adjusted testing conditions and exemptions request form](#) via email to [gtsu@education.wa.edu.au](mailto:gtsu@education.wa.edu.au).

If approved, attach a printed copy of your approval email to the Student Details Form and tick the box on the front of the form. On the day of your workshop, let sign-in staff know that you are an Adjusted Conditions candidate and they will direct you towards the Lead Supervisor.

## Call backs

If your child is successful in the workshop, they will be invited to the callback which will take place on Monday 11–Wednesday 13 March and Sunday 17–Monday 18 March. Students will be required to prepare and memorise a monologue for this callback. This will be provided to you when you receive your callback invitation.
