Ocean Reef Senior High School offers a wide range of specialist courses for students, including marine studies, contemporary music, elite soccer and an extension program for academically talented children.

The school is close to the Indian Ocean, which means students enjoy an active lifestyle filled with swimming and other outdoor activities. Teachers and students are very supportive of international students and welcome them into the school community.

Ocean Reef Senior High School accepts international students in Years 7 to 12.

Education

Ocean Reef Senior High School's teaching and learning programs are designed to be challenging and innovative, stimulating curiosity, creativity and an ability to be reflective, placing students on a pathway that will enable them to realise their aspirations through opportunity. The school employs experienced and highly trained teachers who guide students towards achieving their Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE). They tailor learning to the needs of each child, so every student thrives.

Students can study courses based on the career pathway they want to pursue. This includes studying for the Australian Tertiary Academic Rank (ATAR), which leads to university. As well as opportunities for vocational training and workplace learning.





Support for students

International students are supported by a dedicated student support officer, who takes care of their personal and academic wellbeing. A student services team also support students. The team includes school leaders, a psychologist, a chaplain, and a student services officer.

Students are welcome to join clubs at the school, including study clubs and academic clubs that help them with their learning. There are also gaming and wellbeing clubs and many more activities available to all students.

Settling in

All new students are paired with another student who helps them find classes, meet new people and navigate the school. The student support officer is also available to assist international students during and after school. Regular emails with updates on what students are doing and how they are enjoying their time at Ocean Reef Senior High School are sent to parents. Teachers will email academic updates and the Program Coordinators will email ongoing student issues and activities.

International students can attend English as a Second Language courses as part of the mainstream curriculum. Literacy support is available to all students who need it. The school also has special software that encourages language development.

Location

Ocean Reef Senior High School is 29 kilometres from Perth city centre. Mullaloo Beach is located nearby, as well as amazing restaurants and parks. Students can easily take public transport to Joondalup, which has a public library, leisure centre and fun entertainment.
