Student experiences of boarding at *Geraldton Residential College* can be enhanced by participating in a range of leisure, recreational, cultural and sporting activities which are a key part of boarding life. The following information is provided to enable you to make an informed decision as to your child's participation in these various activities.

Our staff 'have a duty of care to protect students from risk of harm that can reasonably be foreseen'. These leisure activities will be assessed for risk prior to commencement and will not proceed if we consider the activity to be 'high' risk. We employ a number of strategies to reduce the likelihood of risks occurring and the consequences should they eventuate. However, it should be noted that engaging in any recreational activity will carry some risk exposure that cannot be eliminated.
