

- Skill sets to get you skills ready for current job opportunities — **some are free for everyone, others are free for eligible students including displaced workers, concession students and youth up to 25 not at school.**

Free* job ready skill sets

Not all jobs need a full qualification, and maybe you don't either. We've consulted with businesses and employers to deliver fast track training where the jobs are.

- **Operating a Small Business** skill set is 100% free for everyone.
- **Some job ready skill sets are 100% free for eligible people** including displaced workers, concession students and youth up to 25 years (not at school).
- **All skill sets are available for everyone to study**, however if you don't meet the eligibility requirements for the free training you will be required to pay a fee for your course.

Pavilion Restaurant (JK)




A working commercial kitchen providing skills to plan, organise, prepare and serve a la carte food and beverages for diners.

Students care for local children under lecturer supervision.





Our qualifications

Short courses

Pursue your interest and build skills in a specific area to help you get that promotion, change careers or just for fun. Short courses are flexible and affordable.

Skill Sets

Skill sets will give you specific workplace skills and are made up of one or more units of competency linking to an industry need or requirement. Upon completion, you will receive a statement of attainment, in some cases this may give you credit toward a higher qualification.

Certificate I

Cover base-level skills for entry into the workforce. They usually don't require you to have any prior knowledge or education and are a great place to start if you haven't studied in a while, or want a basic introduction to a new field.

Certificate II

Prepares you for entry-level positions or to begin an apprenticeship in a variety of industries. As well as providing basic knowledge, completing a Certificate II demonstrates to a potential employer that you're actively interested in their industry.

Certificate III

Develop your skills, theoretical knowledge and problem-solving abilities. This level of qualification is ideal for those wanting to gain a trade, change careers or move out of entry-level roles.

Certificate IV

For those who want to advance their careers in the industry they already work in, or further develop skills and knowledge acquired through previous study.
